
### MPs in previous Parliament

Previous ALP MPs








## **2022 Candidates**


Both the Coalition and Labor put forward candidates in all 151 electorates for the House of Representatives

- 43% of ALP candidates and 29% of Coalition candidates\* were female.

\*Coalition candidates are defined here using the LNP candidate, or the sitting or more competitive candidate from the Liberal or National parties in states where the parties are separate entities.

## But the raw numbers don't tell the full story

Not only were there fewer women contesting than men – they were also less likely to win

Where did the female ALP candidates stand?




In the ALP, around 24% of female candidates ran in safe seats, compared to 33% of male candidates. **76% of female candidates in the ALP were 'Glass Cliff Candidates'** and ran in seats they were unlikely to win, or that were precarious to hold. The equivalent proportion of men who ran in these seats was 67%.



### Where did the male Coalition candidates stand?




In the Coalition, around 20% of female candidates ran in safe seats, compared to 46% of male candidates. **80% of female candidates in the Coalition were 'Glass Cliff Candidates'** rand ran in seats they were unlikely to win, or that were precarious to hold. The equivalent proportion of men who ran in these seats was 54%.






#### How successful were male ALP candidates?





Labor

Overall, female Labor candidates had a 55% success rate, even higher than men (47%)




Overall, female Coalition candidates had a 23% success rate, much lower than men (43%)

While all major political parties need to do better to improve the diversity of our political representatives, the lower disparity between opportunities provided to male and female candidates in the ALP reflects the longstanding policy of quotas within the party, with greater numbers of women overall and greater numbers in winnable seats.
